In order for this event to be a great success, we are looking for great exhibitors like YOU! You are invited to exhibit your products or services during our C.A.I.R Day Event. C.A.I.R Day is designed to expose the Hunter Army Airfield community to events, business, organizations, clubs, schools, businesses, recreation opportunities and activities in the local community and surrounding areas.

Admission and parking to the event will be free. The event will feature informational booths from local school districts; FREE school supplies for Military Families; opportunities for individuals to learn about and register for clubs, organizations, and classes, recreational and cultural opportunities; learn about local businesses and restaurants and about what the local community has to offer Soldiers and Families while stationed at Fort Stewart/Hunter AAF.

Participants will receive a passport as they enter the facility, vendors will stamp their passports as they visit their booth and as the customers exit the event they will be entered into a drawing for some great door prizes. Participants must have received 65% of the vendor stamps to be eligible for door prizes.

- Fees: Vendor fees are attached. Standard booth space is 10' wide X 10' deep. Booth space will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Product Sales: While promoting products and services is allowed, the actual selling of products will not be allowed. Vendors may provide coupons and store discounts. It is the responsibility of each vendor to make sure they have the necessary solicitation permits for Fort <u>Stewart/Hunter AAF</u>. A one-day solicitation permit will be easily obtained by calling 912-767-5139. Vendors are encouraged to provide giveaways to participants who visit their booth.
- Food Vendors: Samples are encouraged. All food handlers must attend a free, one hour food handler's course at Hunter Army Airfield in order to sell or give away food at the event. Attendees will receive a food handler's certificate that must be displayed at your booth. Certificate is valid for one year.
- Tents: Vendors must supply their own tents if cover is preferred. The main event site will be inside the Newman Physical Fitness Center with overflow space outside.
- Electricity: Limited electrical outlets will be available. Outdoor booths may bring their own generators. Vendors must ground generators and have a fire extinguisher on site.
- Tables/Chairs: One 6ft table and two chairs will be provided for each 10x10 space. Table covers are highly recommended but will not be provided.
